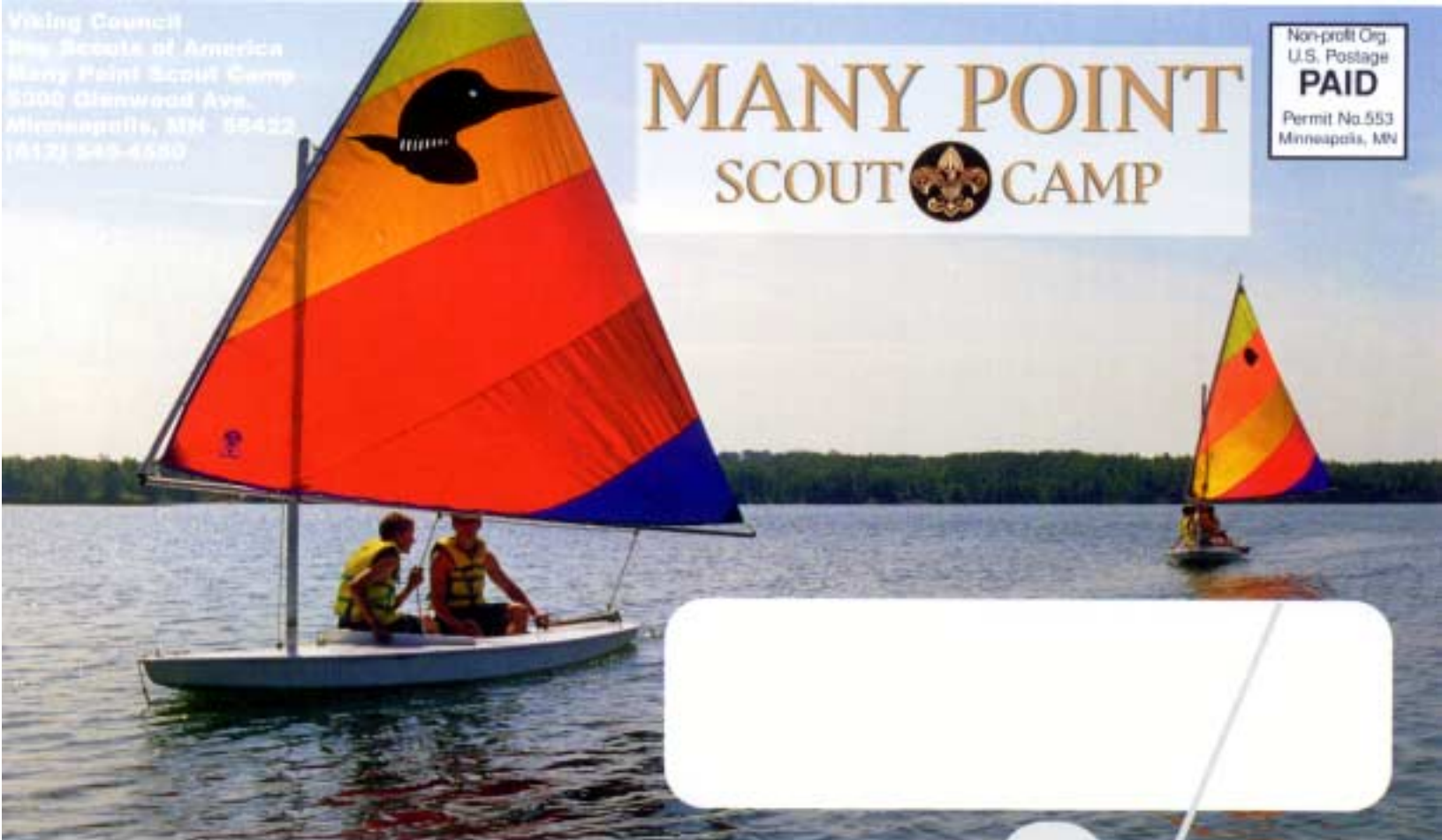

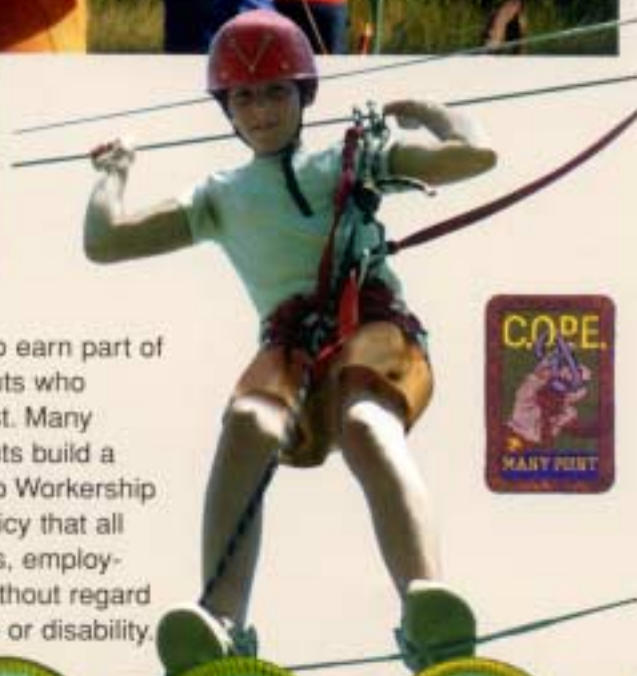
FAMILY CAMP

C.I.T. PROGRAM
